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CINDE

CINDE Foundation was established on October 20, 2006 as a non-profit foundation for general interest purposes, predominantly development cooperation, by Ministerial Order of January 16, 2007, under the No. 28-1423.

Its main purpose is to support the work carried out by the CINDE Association in El Salvador, which began in 1989 in the city of Soyapango, motivated by the difficult living conditions of hundreds of impoverished women from urban areas who dedicated themselves to street vendors, while caring for and attending for their children on the streets.

EARLY CHILDHOOD CARE

In 2021, the number of children enrolled in the Early Childhood Development Centers between the ages of 2 and 6, was 149. We are still not at the number of students enrolled in the years prior to the pandemic (approximately 200 children), since the fear of the families of a possible contagion continues to be the reason why they do not school.

This program provides quality education in the early childhood stage, adequate nutrition for the child's proper physical development, and mental health care.

In addition, workshops are offered and recommended to mothers, fathers, and/or guardians of minors with the aim of incorporating positive parenting practices at the family level and influencing their communities to improve protective practices and a culture of peace that guarantee the rights of children and youth.

For the fifth consecutive year, Mapfre foundation was one of the main financiers of this program in 2021. In addition, the company's employees in El Salvador regularly visit children's centers to bring gifts, educational material or a special meal to the kids.

We remain convinced that investing on early childhood is investing on a brighter future of El Salvador.

AFTER-SCHOOL PROGRAMS

During 2021, the after-school program spaces were operating in four urban municipalities of San Salvador: Mejicanos, Soyapango, Ciudad Delgado and Ayutuxtepeque.

124 children and teenagers from 7 to 15 years old attended these spaces daily, during 3- hour days in the afternoon, to receive support in carrying out school tasks and homework strengthen their knowledge of mathematics, language and reading comprehension and attend to psychosocial skill-building workshops.

The participation of minors in this program favors their permanence in the school system, the knowledge of their rights, participation in leisure activities, and ultimately to relate to other children in the community in a safe and healthy environment.

CULTURE OF PEACE IN COMMUNITIES

In 2021, various workshops were held with children, teenagers, youth from the Community Youth Committees and adults in different municipalities.

In total, 595 people participated (63 girls, 47 boys, 17 teenage women, 18 teenage men and 450 adults). In addition, 13 cases of special follow-up due to psychological violence and behavior problems were addressed.

The workshops that have been carried out were:

- 1) Workshops with children and teenagers: 300 face-to-face workshops were held with the participation of 110 minors. Topics such as empathy, assertive communication, structural violence, gender and healthy eating, were addressed ,among others.
- 2) Workshops with young people: (Community Youth Committees): 44 advocacy strengthening workshops were held with the participation of 34 young people.
- 3) Training workshops “Families Forging the Future”: 450 adults participated (mothers, fathers, adult caregivers). The workshops were held on positive parenting practices at the family level, achieving that 69.5% identified different forms of violence against children, the situations that can trigger attachment traumas and the role and responsibility of adults in the protection of the minor.

STUDY SCHOLARSHIPS

The Study Scholarships program was created in 2006 when it was found that young people who attended school tutoring and who had previously received education and comprehensive care in the Early Childhood Development Centers had the desire to continue training and studying, but did not have the financial resources to do so. Since then, more than 140 young people have been able to continue their studies thanks to the help of the scholarships.

In 2021, 35 scholarships were awarded to young people with funds from two donors: the Atlacatl Fund for Education and the CINDE Foundation.

- ⇒ University scholarships: 21 young people received a scholarship to pursue degrees in psychology, communication sciences, social work, languages, plastic arts, clinical laboratory, etc. In 2022, some of these young people will obtain their official university degree because they will have finished their higher education.
- ⇒ Baccalaureate scholarships: 12 young people attend high school thanks to a scholarship that covers their tuition costs and part of the costs of transport and didactic material.
- ⇒ Scholarships for basic education: 1 girl (6th grade) and 1 boy (1st grade) are completing their compulsory education studies thanks to a scholarship that covers their registration fees, part of the transportation costs and teaching materials.

SCHOOL OF MOTHERS AND FATHERS

The workshops and training meetings of the School of Mothers and Fathers program aim to sensitize and educate this group on various issues that concern children and teenagers and their role in the family.

It is essential to involve the parents of minors cared for in the early childhood development centers in their education and get them to commit to giving all their support to their children and to change the methods of discipline based on physical punishment, so ingrained in the way of raising children in El Salvador, for a model of positive discipline.

Through participations in this program, 59 mothers, fathers and adult caregivers identified different forms of violence against children, the situations that can trigger attachment traumas in childhood and the role and responsibility of adults in the protection of minors. In addition, they developed a campaign called "Educating with Love", through the CINDE social page, which lasted three months. More than eight videos and 10 pieces of art were viewed that promoted the importance of educating with love and the experience as mothers and fathers in the CINDE processes.

WOMEN BUILDERS OF ALTERNATIVES

The objective of the program is to organize women into groups and form Solidarity Microcredit Banks that make it easier for them to obtain credit for their businesses and, in turn, create the habit of saving. This gives them a real, fair alternative to borrowing from unscrupulous lenders who charge them abusive interest rates of up to 20%.

In 2021, 481 loans were granted in the municipalities of Mejicanos, Soyapango, Ayutuxtepeque and Ciudad Delgado with the participation of 138 women. In total, 38,522.00 euros in loans have been granted.

VOLUNTEERING

In 2021, a group of three students from the "International Master's Degree in Psychology of Catastrophes, Crisis and Emergencies" (from the Ilustre Colegio Oficial de Psicología de Andalucía Oriental) traveled from Spain to El Salvador to support CINDE's projects. Their stay was two weeks, during which they gave talks and psychosocial workshops to children, youth and women from the different programs, as well as to the team of teachers, as part of their end-of-year master's degree internship.

Specifically, this group of psychologists carried out socio-educational and self-care processes on managing emotions with children and women. They also held a training workshop with the CINDE Association staff on psychological first aid care mechanisms.

Since 2006, through the International Volunteering program, many young people and adults have traveled from Spain to live this enriching experience and selflessly contribute their help to some of the projects carried out through activities such as:

- ⇒ Support for the teachers of the Early Childhood Development Centers
- ⇒ After school programs for children and young people between 7 and 15 years
- ⇒ English classes and computing
- ⇒ Training workshops for women
- ⇒ Recreational-sports days in the communities, etc.

In addition, we have numerous volunteers who support us in Spain in the different activities that we carry out to raise funds, in office work and promoting and disseminating the work of CINDE.




